



### A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear MedGlobalists,

Since 2017, MedGlobal has provided accessible healthcare to refugees, displaced peoples, and host communities around the globe affected by armed conflict, natural disasters, lack of resources, and climate change.

2019 was a fruitful year for our young organization. With your support, our diverse medical teams have been able to treat vulnerable patients in the most challenging disaster regions, in partnership with international and local NGOs to empower communities.

By embracing innovation, technology, and training, we have been able to build resilient communities dealing with the aftermath of man-made or natural disasters including Yemen, Syria, Lebanon, Rohingya - Bangladesh, Sierra Leone, Greece, Kurdistan - Iraq, Colombia - Venezuela, Pakistan, and Gaza.

Thus far, we have provided dignified healthcare to more than 155,000 patients by over 530 medical professionals in 14 countries, donated more than three million dollars of in-kind donations of medications supplies and equipment, gave more than 35,000 hours of professional medical services by our volunteers and distributed more than four million dollars of medical supplies, equipment, and life-saving medications.

Together with your support, our committed volunteers traveled to challenging regions and performed more than 25 training courses, including Helping Babies Breathe, point-of-care ultrasound, nursing care, mental health, disaster management, empathy training, non-communicable disease, critical care, and emergency medicine, to more than 1,500 local healthcare professionals.

To uplift the voices of the populations we've served, our advocacy team met with stakeholders at the highest levels of the United Nations, world governments, global health, public health, and US policymakers.

Our work has been covered across global media outlets including The New York Times, CNN, BBC, Al-Jazeera, PBS, and as well as countless others. Our social media reached millions of people throughout the world.

We invite you to review our annual report, which not only highlights our achievements and impact in 2019 but recognizes our generous supporters who have helped those most in need.

At MedGlobal, we believe that even small acts of generosity can create a world without healthcare disparity.

### **ADVOCACY**

At MedGlobal, our doctors, nurses, and team members advocate on behalf of refugees, displaced persons, and the other vulnerable populations we serve, as well as on behalf of our local partners, in order to shape and change policies, increase funding to life-saving programs to help marginalized communities, and raise awareness among the general public and media about important global health issues.

#### What is advocacy?

Advocacy is a way to create change through influencing policy.

#### How does MedGlobal use advocacy?

At MedGlobal, our advocacy aims to raise awareness about the reality people face in humanitarian crises and low-resource settings, and influence decision-makers to adopt policies and take actions to promote the health of the most vulnerable populations. Our staff and volunteers work:

- To give a greater platform to the populations we serve.
- To engage with stakeholders and policymakers.
- To build deeper partnerships with other NGOs and health institutions at a local, national, and international level.
- To influence policy and create change.

The following are some of MedGlobal advocacy initiatives in 2019:

- Health Cluster participation at a local level. MedGlobal was an active participant in the Health Clusters in Bangladesh and Colombia
- Working with Ministries of Health on-the-ground. MedGlobal met with the Gaza Mini try of Health and Kurdistan Regional Government (Iraq) Ministry of Health to coordinate health efforts and discuss health systems
- Presenting our work to key policy and health communities. MedGlobal leaders worked with numerous partners and stakeholders, including participation at a Center for Stratgic and International Studies (CSIS) roundtable on the Venezuela crisis, presenting on MedGlobal's humanitarian work at the Consortium of Universities for Global Health (CUGH) annual confeence, and contributing to side events UN General Assembly on "Tackling the Imbalances at the Heart of Humanitarian Response."
- Meeting with key stakeholders from the U.S. government and UN. The MedGlobal team has met with high level policymakers and stakeholders from the Department of State; USAID; Congressional offices and members of Congress, including Congresswo an Ilhan Omar, Congresswoman Rashida Tlaib, and Congressman Jesús "Chuy" García; and numerous UN delegations.
- Publishing in-depth reports. MedGlobal has published in-depth research and policy reports, including <u>In the Eye of the Cyclone: The Challenges of Providing Health Care</u> <u>for Rohingya Refugees During Monsoon Season</u> and <u>Addressing the HIV Crisis among Venezuelan Migrants in Colombia.</u>
- Generating media. The MedGlobal team has generated media and op-eds highlighting the needs of refugees in humanitarian crises, including in The New York Times, Chicago Tribune, CBS Chicago, The Independent, and more.

# **PROGRAMS**



"Creating a world without healthcare disparity"

MedGlobal is a US-based, charitable 501(c)(3) medical international non-governmental organization (INGO). MedGlobal's diverse teams partner with local communities in regions affected by disaster, displacement, scarcity, and climate change in order to build resilience and improve access to quality healthcare. We provide training, innovation, technology, and medical interventions to deliver sustainable and dignified health, healing and well-being.

MedGlobal was founded based on humanitarian principles by a group of doctors and nurses in August 2017 with the vision of reducing healthcare disparity focusing on refugees, migrants, and other vulnerable populations living in disaster regions and low-resource countries. MedGlobal aligns its global medical programs with the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals on Good Health and Wellbeing and building sustainable and resilient communities and cities.

The focus of the organization is to ensure long-lasting and sustainable impact through:

- Disasters and Emergency Response
- Health Services
- Mental Health and Psychosocial Support
- Health Training and Education
  - Critical Care in Low-Resource Countries

- Disaster Management
- Empathy Training
- Mental Health Training

# ROHINGYA -BANGLADESH



#### ROHINGYA – BANGLADESH SUSTAINABLE OPERATION

August 2019 marked the two-year anniversary of what has been deemed an "ethnic cleansing" of the Rohingya, an ethnic minority in Myanmar. This unscrupulous initiative led to the evacuation of over 742,000 Rohingya to neighboring Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh. The vast majority of this population is female; 15.5% of these women are pregnant/lactating and nearly 40% are less than 12 years old. The future of the Rohingya remains uncertain as they continue to remain stateless and in need of emergency humanitarian assistance for food, shelter, nutrition, education and health care. Nearly 30% of the land in Cox's Bazar's Kutupalong-Balukhali camp is prone to landslides resulting from heavy rainfall and is susceptible to risks from other natural disasters, including cyclones. Epidemic diseases such as Diphtheria, Measles, Cholera, Varicella, and Hepatitis continue to threaten the refugee population due to overcrowding and limited access to healthcare services.

Since October 2017, MedGlobal has worked in collaboration with various national and international partner non-government organizations to serve more than 102,000 Rohingya beneficiaries. MedGlobal has been providing primary care in accordance with the Minimum Package of Essential Health Services for Primary Healthcare Facilities for Forcefully Displaced Myanmar Nationals. We aim to minimize mortality, improve health and nutritional well-being, and provide emergency care for children and care for those with chronic illnesses. Children less than 5 years old compromise more than 20% of the consultations performed.

In addition to providing medical services, MedGlobal has participated in several capacity building initiatives for the local medical community in Cox's Bazar. To date, we have provided training in Helping Babies Breathe and trauma-informed care to 229 participants and shared our work in a Knowledge Sharing Symposium hosted by the World Health Organization.





#### **MEDGLOBAL**

In the future, MedGlobal plans to extend these efforts by providing mental health services, leading quality improvement projects, and creating additional capacity building initiatives for the local medical community.

## VENEZUELA -COLOMBIA



### VENEZUELA - COLOMBIA SUSTAINABLE OPERATION

Political and socioeconomic turmoil and human rights violations in Venezuela have resulted in the largest exodus of people from a single country in Latin American and the Caribbean. In 2019, more than 4.6 million Venezuelans left the country, fleeing from violence, insecurity, and threats, and seeking essential food, medicine, and services; up to 1.6 million people are currently being hosted in Colombia. It is reported that over half of Venezuelan migrants in Colombia have an illegal status. Thisprevents them from receiving critical healthcare services and makes them vulnerable to exploitation and abuse, violence, and discrimination.

Starting in April 2019, MedGlobal partnered with Institucion Prestadora de Servicio Medcare Colombia S.A.S. to operate a primary care clinic in Cucuta, Norte de Santander, Colombia, a town on the border of Venezuela. In this setting, MedGlobal serves Venezuelan migrants, refugees, and underserved Colombians. MedGlobal follows the priorities of the Healthcare Response Plan for the Migrant Population, which includes implementing an information system and delivering medical support to populations who need it most, including pregnant women, children under 5 years old, and patients with chronic diseases including cardiovascular disease and mental health. In addition, MedGlobal provides oral hygiene, laboratory, nutritional, and psychiatric services. MedGlobal has also participated in several outreach health fairs and advocacy events, reaching a total of 17,151 beneficiaries in 2019.





In the future, MedGlobal plans to expand our services and our outreach efforts. This will include expansion of services in the current clinic to include a dentist and first aid services; expanded nutritional services for pregnant and lactating women; completion of quality improvement projects; and, by opening a first-contact clinic at the Francisco de Paula Santander International Bridge.

#### **GREECE SUSTAINABLE OPERATION**

Since 2015, more than 1 million refugees and migrants have been registered in Greece. The majority are from Afghanistan (40%), Syria (27%) and the Democratic Republic of the Congo (7%). Of these, more than 100,000 refugees have passed through Lesvos Island. On Lesvos, there are two refugee camps: Moria Camp and the smaller Kara Tepe Refugee Camp. Moria Camp is a Reception and Identification Center; it receives all new arrivals and provides registration and full medical screening services. As such, personnel at Moria Camp are responsible for establishing the medical needs of all incoming refugees. The camp has now exceeded 18,000 people, although it was built to house less than 3,000. As a result, the sanitary and housing conditions are dire.

Since 2018, MedGlobal has partnered with Kitrinos Healthcare, a UK-based nonprofit that offers medical care to Moria Camp residents through a dedicated team of international volunteers. In collaboration with Kitrinos, MedGlobal provides continuous care to the refugee population through a primary care clinic in Moria Camp.

In 2019, MedGlobal and Kitrinos Healthcare's international volunteers provided 28,007 patient consultations. Common services included evaluation and treatment of acute, intermittent illnesses and provision of psychosocial support. In addition, MedGlobal supplies the clinic with necessary medications, medical supplies, and equipment.


# LEBANON



#### **LEBANON MEDICAL MISSION, APRIL 2019**

Recent estimates indicate that there are nearly 1.5 million Syrian refugees in Lebanon. Of these refugees, 83% report at least one family member who suffers from a chronic disease and nearly 2.5% report a need for mental healthcare. Chronic diseases and mental health conditions are difficult and expensive to manage and treat. In addition, in order to mitigate long-term complications, a continuity of care and access to secondary and tertiary health services is required. For these reasons, the economic burden of these conditions on afflicted individuals and on their communities is tremendous. Refugees in Lebanon suffering from chronic diseases and mental health conditions lack the resources to seek medical treatment, and the fragmented healthcare system in Lebanon is not equipped to take responsibility for their care.

To meet the greatest needs in the region, MedGlobal returned to Lebanon in 2019 to provide specialized surgical, cardiac and medical services to refugee populations in the Beqaa Valley and Arsal.

# KURDISTAN - IRAQ



#### KURDISTAN REGION OF IRAQ MEDICAL MISSION, APRIL 2019

Since 2016, ongoing violence within Iraq has led to a mass internal displacement of over 3.3 million citizens The Kurdistan Region of Iraq has also experienced an influx of refugees, who have primarily fled from Syria. In total, 6.7 million people, or 18% of Iraq's population, are in need of humanitarian assistance. The destruction of healthcare facilities and the loss of healthcare providers who have fled the region has greatly strained the healthcare system. There is a need for humanitarian services that provide human, financial, and other resources in order to build sustainable access to quality healthcare services in Iraq.

In 2019, MedGlobal deployed a team of specialized medical volunteers to the Kurdistan Region of Iraq to provide primary healthcare services to those in need. Services were provided in areas with internally displaced people (IDP) and in a refugee camp, as well as through community outreach in a mobile clinic.



Additionally, medications and supplies were procured for 2,000 beneficiaries. Several training courses were offered to the local medical community in areas identified as the greatest need.

# GAZA



#### **GAZA MEDICAL MISSION, JUNE 2019**

In the Occupied Palestinian Territoriesan estimated 2.5 million people are in need of humanitarian assistance; 1.6 million are in the Gaza Strip. The Great March of Return demonstrations in 2018 exacerbated the crisis because of the many casualties and the great number who suffered from significant traumatic injuries requiring complex surgeries. The need to prioritize care for critically injured patients, and restrictions on patient referrals for outside care, has resulted in significant delays in all other healthcare services. There is a chronic shortage of medical and surgical supplies, and nearly one-half (47%) of medications are at "zero stock level," indicating that there is less than a one month supply. Gaza's healthcare system was already strained, and the challenges that have arisen since 2018 are resulting in total overwhelm.

MedGlobal, in partnership with the Palestinian American Medical Association (PAMA) and in coordination with the Ministry of Health, deployed a medical mission to the Gaza Strip. During the mission, a team of experienced healthcare professionals provided both medical and surgical services to beneficiaries who struggle with access to healthcare as well as training opportunities for local healthcare providers. Additionally, critically needed medical supplies and medications were distributed to several hospitals in the Gaza Strip.







#### **MEDGLOBAL**

There is a protracted humanitarian crisis in the Occupied Palestinian Territories. Overall, an estimated **2.5 million people** are in need of humanitarian assistance, of which **1.6 million** are in the Gaza Strip.

# YEMEN



## YEMEN MEDICAL MISSION, NOVEMBER 2019

The largest humanitarian crisis in the world is in Yemen. In 2019, an estimated 24.1 million people – 80% of the population – were in need of humanitarian assistance or protection, with 14.3 million in acute need of assistance. Public services have deteriorated; only 51% of health facilities remain "fully functional," and the rest are either closed or only partially functioning due to a shortage of staff, supplies, financial resources, medications, and equipment. Even in hospitals classified as "fully functional," most equipment is non-functioning or obsolete. There are 10 health workers per 10,000 people, less than half the WHO minimum benchmark.

In 2019, MedGlobal sent a team of medical volunteers to both the Hadhramout and Marib Governorates; they provided medical and surgical services and specialized training courses to the local medical community. MedGlobal also joined forces with Project HOPE, Pure Hands, and United Mission for Relief and Development to form the **Humanitarian Alliance for Yemen**. This alliance was formed with the intention of strengthening the humanitarian response by combining members' experience and resources to support Yemen's nutrition and health sectors.

MedGlobal has provided several educational initiatives in Yemen, including the Helping Babies Breathe program, and training on emergency medical triage and trauma stabilization, critical care, and infection control.





We use a "Train-the-Trainer" model, which equips trainees to become trainers for subsequent courses in their local communities. This model is more sustainable than a traditional model, where trainers are deployed repeatedly to teach courses.

# **PAKISTAN**



## **PAKISTAN MEDICAL MISSION. NOVEMBER 2019**

According to the United Nations' Human Development Index, out of 189 countries, Pakistan is the 150th least developed country in the world. A shortage of material, financial, human, and other resources is most pronounced in rural areas. This disparity is evidenced by key markers tracked by the World Health Organization (WHO), including infant mortality rates. Pakistan ranks near the top 10% of infant mortality in the world, meaning that national infant mortality is worse than in 90% of the world's other countries, and less than 50% of women receive the recommended minimum antenatal care of at least 4 visits during pregnancy.

MedGlobal teamed up with the Indus Health Network, a not-for-profit organization in Pakistan that aims to provide free healthcare that is accessible to all. MedGlobal organized a mission of 16 international healthcare providers, who traveled to Pakistan with the goal of building the capacity of the local healthcare community, particularly those serving rural areas. The MedGlobal team committed to the delivery of education in the "Train-the-Trainer" model to extend the impact of services provided long after completion of the mission.

# **EDUCATION**



Education and training are at the core of MedGlobal's sustainable and impactful global work. Our education projects target the following:

### **Healthcare Professionals**

We believe in investing in local, frontline healthcare professionals, empowering them through developing their skills and abilities in their respective fields. Our medical missions are consistently providing continued medical education tailored to our partners' priorities.

#### **Healthcare Students**

Our commitment to medical education reflects our mission to equip the future generation of healthcare professionals with the knowledge and skills to better serve migrant populations worldwide. In 2019, we welcomed several medical students with their mentors at our international sites and included opportunities to be involved in community and quality improvement projects. Our 2020 projects will include an immersive refugee health elective and medical student internships.

## Patient Education

To ensure our healthcare services are empowering to our beneficiaries, our clinics and medical missions incorporate various elements of patient education: from group counseling on specific diseases to individualized patient counseling - a vital yet limited service in the humanitarian healthcare setting.

# FEATURED 2019 EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS



#### **Helping Babies Breathe (HBB)**

HBB is an evidence-based educational program developed by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and global partners to teach neonatal resuscitation techniques specifically for resource-limited settings. In 2019, MedGlobal volunteers conducted HBB training courses in Bangladesh, Yemen, and Pakistan, providing training to 339 providers, 41 instructors, and 10 new Master Trainers.

The instructors trained by MedGlobal have gone on to train at least 133 other healthcare providers since receiving their training, promoting sustainable education.

In 2020, MedGlobal will be partnering up with the AAP and academic groups to further develop the curriculum and reach of the program.

#### Point-of-Care Ultrasound (POCUS)

In 2019, Medglobal collaborated with an inspiring group of ultrasound-certified volunteer physicians to launch a POCUS program in Gaza, Pakistan, and Yemen. The course duration was 3 to 5 days and consisted of a needs assessment prior to in-field training and hands-on training component.

In 2020, the program will continue to be developed and expanded with an aim to reach more trainees and conduct impact assessments. In addition to providing this training program, MedGlobal leverages technology to increase the reach of educational efforts through the donation of handheld, point-of-care ultrasound probes that can connect to a basic tablet or smartphone and can be used to share images electronically back to master trainers across the world for review and consultation.






